The Department for Education Financial Regulations and the Audit Code require The Kemnal Academies Trust (TKAT) to maintain a register of Business and Pecuniary Interests for all Key Personnel in positions of influence and any Related Party to that individual.

Note to Governors/Directors: In addition to completing this form at the start of the year, you must update the Clerk/Company Secretary if information changes through the year and continue to declare any business interests relating to agenda items in the normal way at the start of any LGB/Board meeting.

Key Personnel

The following are deemed to be Key Personnel: Members; Trustees; members of the Audit & Finance Committees; TKAT Senior Leadership Team; members of a Local Governing Body; SLT Members at an Academy; all Finance Staff (at Centre and in individual Academies); clerks of LGBs and the Company Secretary.

Related Party Relationships inc. Connected entities

We require a full list of related parties (as defined below). However you may claim an exemption from providing this information in respect of family members where there is no likelihood of them being involved in a transaction with TKAT or any of its academies. **You only need to declare a related party benefit if one exists.**

A related party is:

- A relative is defined as: a close member of the family, or member of the same household, who may be expected to influence, or be influenced by, the person. This includes, but is not limited to, a child, parent, grandchild, grandparent, sibling, spouse or civil partner
- an individual or organisation carrying on business in partnership with the key personnel or a relative of the key personnel (as described above)

This is required in order that anyone involved in spending public money is able to demonstrate that they or their related party does not benefit personally from decisions that are made. Similarly, a related party must also avoid practices such as obtaining goods and services for their private gain from suppliers connected with TKAT whether or not such goods and services are paid from grant funds.

A Connected Entity is:

- a company in which the key personnel or a relative of the key personnel (taken separately or together), holds more than 20% of the share capital or is entitled to exercise more than 20% of the voting power at any general meeting of that company (e.g. where a committee member has a controlling interest in any other company, that company is a Connected Entity of the Trust and Academies included within the group). For Trustees this is further extended to any company they have any shares in (except a public company listed on the stock exchange and which the Trustee holds less than 1% of issued capital)
- an organisation which is controlled by the key personnel or a relative of the key personnel (acting separately or together). For these purposes an organisation is controlled by an individual or organisation if that individual or organisation is able to secure that the affairs of the body are conducted in accordance with the individual's or organisation's wishes

What must be declared for all Key Personnel and related parties (as defined above)

- directorships, partnerships and employments with any relevant businesses (all employments must be declared, but it is only likely to be senior posts that will impact on transactions with TKAT)
- trusteeships and governorships at other educational institutions and charities
- employment of related parties within TKAT or any of its academies. Where related parties of key personnel are employed within TKAT, they need to be declared on the form, however, **the value of contracts of employment need not be declared.**
- Any connected entities as outlined above, including relevant subsidiary companies of the entity.
- Contractors who are deemed Key Personnel need to declare payments by TKAT/Academy received by themselves, their employing company or their host School/Academy outside the TKAT Trust.
