Dear Parent/Guardian of YEAR1 pupil

Your child was due to be screened for their vision and hearing in the spring/summer term of their reception year. Due to the closure of schools during this time, we were unable to complete the screening.

The aim of this screening is to identify hearing and vision difficulties that haven't been recognised previously and would benefit from further investigation. The impact of COVID-19 continues to be felt, and as a result we are regrettably unable to provide this screening to all children who missed the opportunity earlier in the year.

If you have concerns about your child's vision, which they aren't already receiving care for, we recommend that you make an appointment at your local high street opticians for a free eye test.

Key issues to consider in deciding whether your child needs an eye test are if:

- there is a family history of eye problems
- one eye is turning in or out
- the child complaining of regular headaches or sore eyes
- the child consistently rubbing or screwing up one or both eyes
- the child is holding things close to them related to them being able to see, not a habit

If you have concerns about your child's hearing, which they aren't already receiving care for, please contact school health service to arrange screening in school in the spring and summer terms in 2021. To do this please contact us using the detail at the top of this letter by Wednesday 16th December 2020.

If your level of concern means you do not think this delay is appropriate please contact your GP.

Key issues to consider in deciding whether you are concerned about your child's hearing are:

- if they aren't clear when they speak
- don't reply when you call them
- talk very loudly
- ask you to repeat yourself or respond inappropriately to questions
- turn up the volume of the TV very high
- If there are any of the concerns above and they were born outside of the UK and did not receive a newborn hearing screen.
